- Owners of heavy-duty diesel vehicles, equipment, marine vessels or locomotives based and operating in Maine
- Equipment or vehicles must be maintained and have five years of projected useful life remaining
- Technology must be installed after January 1, 2010

- Shore Connection Systems and Alternative Maritime Power
- Shore Connection Systems for Locomotives
- Auxiliary Power Units and Generator Sets
- Fuel Operated Heaters
- Battery Air Conditioning Systems
- Thermal Storage Systems
- Automatic Shut-down/ Start-Up Systems

1. The customer information (name, company, address)
2. Vehicle mileage at replacement
3. Vehicle VIN number (all 17 characters should be listed)
4. Date the work was completed
5. A description of the installation
6. Installed equipment serial number
7. Cost of installation and equipment (pre-tax) for specified rebate amount
(Rebate is equal to 25% of equipment and installation cost pre-tax)
8. Documentation that the APU or heater has been installed and paid in full (i.e. paid in full stamp)
9. Date paid

NOTE: All of the information requested in the sections above is required for the applicant to be eligible to apply for this rebate program.

SECTION 4: VEHICLE OWNER STATEMENT

5. I understand that Efficiency Maine does not endorse any company that requests information on this application and does not sell information as a mailing list.

I hereby (a) release Efficiency Maine and its officers, employees, and agents, and agree to defend and indemnify the foregoing from and against any claims, demands, or costs (including attorney and expert witness fees at trial and on appeal) arising from or in any way related to claims made by applicant or any parent or subsidiary of applicant and which are related in any way to Efficiency Maine's approval or disapproval of the rebate; and (b) agree to reimburse Efficiency Maine for any damages, costs and expenses, including, but not limited to attorney fees and reasonable expenses for staff and legal counsel incurred as a result of, or arising from or in any way related to the applicant obtaining rebate by fraud or misrepresentation.

8. I understand that the vehicle I am installing the equipment on must have at least five years useful life left and that I must keep the vehicle for at least five years after receiving the rebate.
9. I verify that the equipment is certified to meet California emissions.
10. I understand that if any information is missing from this application, Efficiency Maine reserves the right to reject the application.
11. I verify that the project owner does not restrict membership, sales, or services on the basis of race, color, creed, religion, national origin, sexual preference or gender.
12. I have completed this form to the best of my knowledge and have not altered any of these statements.
13. I certify that I am the vehicle owner or the authorized agent. By signing this statement, I acknowledge that I have read and agree with the terms and conditions of the Vehicle Owner Statement and have not altered any part of the statement.
