4,000 Homes Challenge

Funded by the federal American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) stimulus plan Program Goals:

- Weatherize and upgrade 4,000 homes
- 25% average total overall energy savings

Conservation Services Group (CSG) is the Program Administrator hired by Efficiency Maine

Eligibility and Process

Eligible Projects:

- Maine homes occupied and heated year round
- ➤ 1 4 dwelling unit structures
- All income levels are eligible (Note: Low Income residents should be referred to Maine State Housing Authority for free services)

Process Requirements:

- At least 25% energy savings from heat + DHW
- > Audits from January 1, 2009 & on are eligible
- Pre-installation review and pre-approval required!





Incentives

Tier 1 Incentive:

- At least 25% energy savings from heat + DHW
- > Earn incentive of 30% of total installed cost
- > Incentive capped at \$1,500 per dwelling unit

Tier 2 Incentive:

- At least 50% energy savings from heat + DHW
- ➤ Earn incentive of 50% of total installed cost
- Incentive capped at \$3,000 per dwelling unit

Federal Tax Credits may also be applicable.





Eligible Measures

- Air sealing (required if applicable)
- Insulation (required if applicable)
- High efficiency heating equipment
- High efficiency DHW equipment
- Programmable T-stats and other controls
- Solar water heating
- Low-flow showerheads and aerators
- Energy Star[™] windows





Review and Pre-Approval

Energy Audit Requirements:

- Must be completed by certified auditor/analyst
- > Audits completed in 2009 are eligible
- Must be modeled with approved software

Program Review and Pre-Approval:

- Review and Pre-Approval required before installation
- Must submit audit input data, audit report, and copy of contractor scope of work showing all costs

CSG's Maine staff and procedures are a work in process and will evolve in the weeks ahead.





Installation Requirements

Building Performance Institute (BPI):

- Technical installation standards based upon BPI
- BPI certified BA or EP must be responsible for project
- Installations subject to random Program inspections

Incentive Payments:

- > Incentives to be paid to contractors after completion
- Invoices to show all costs and incentive deduction

ARRA Requirements:

- "Buy American" provisions may apply to materials
- Davis-Bacon Act wages apply to all installation labor
