The undersigned acknowledges that the federal Build America, Buy America Act (BABA) requires that certain federally-funded "infrastructure projects" (which include, among other facilities, structures, and equipment, electric vehicle (EV) charging stations) meet domestic assembly standards and that "all of the iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in the project are produced in the United States."

Therefore, as a condition of receiving or retaining payments under this federally-funded contract, and except to the extent that a specific federal waiver applies, the undersigned Recipient/Contractor certifies as follows:

1. All EV charging equipment used in the Project was assembled in the United States.
2. All iron and steel used in the Project was produced in the United States, including the manufacture of EV charger enclosures and housing predominantly of steel or iron.
3. The cost of components manufactured domestically for EV charging equipment meets the Build America, Buy America requirement of at least fifty-five percent (55%) domestic content for manufactured products (unless another standard for determining the minimum amount of domestic content of the manufactured product has been established under another applicable law or regulation).
4. All construction materials used in the Project were produced in the United States.
5. Any equipment that does not meet the Build America, Buy America requirement of 55% domestic content has been or will be installed no later than October 1, 2024.
6. Recipient/Contractor will obtain from all manufacturers and suppliers of iron, steel, manufactured products, and construction materials used in the Project proper documentation and additional certifications demonstrating compliance with Build America, Buy America requirements and shall retain and make such documentation and certifications available to Efficiency Maine and the funding authority upon request.
7. By signing any payment application or other request for payment from Efficiency Maine in connection with the Project, Recipient/Contractor certifies they have reviewed documentation for all products and materials included in the request for payment, and the documentation is sufficient to demonstrate compliance with Build America, Buy America Act requirements.

The undersigned Recipient/Contractor certifies and affirms the truthfulness and accuracy of each of the foregoing statements and representations and acknowledges that there are penalties for false claims and statements under applicable law.
