



## HESP Incentive

Up to \$1,500 for Qualifying Home Energy Upgrades  
Two Paths to Access Rebates

### Path 1 (Custom)

**Tier 1** \$1,000 for  $\geq 20\%$  Energy Savings

OR

**Tier 2** \$1,500 for  $\geq 40\%$  Energy Savings

### Path 2 (Menu)

1. \$400 for Air Sealing with Assessment
2. \$100 Next Step Bonus for one additional Menu measure in conjunction with Air Sealing with Assessment
3. \$500 - \$1,000 for Insulation
4. \$250 - \$500 for Qualified Supplemental Heating Systems
5. \$500 for High Efficiency Central Heating Systems
6. \$5,000 for Central Heating Wood Pellet Boilers and Geothermal Heating Systems

## General Program Guidelines

- Eligible buildings include single family dwellings and 2-4 unit buildings; occupancy must be either owner occupied, year-round or rental with annual lease. Previous HESP Rebate Program Participants (2010-2011) and Previous Air Sealing Promotion Participants in 2-4 Unit buildings are ineligible;
- Other incentive programs may be available outside of the \$1,500 incentive limit (Ex. Summit Natural Gas, Unitil, Efficiency Maine Appliance Rebate);
