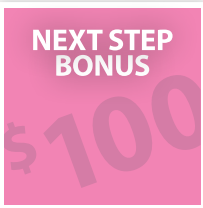

INSULATION **\$500** per zone; up to **\$1,500** rebate

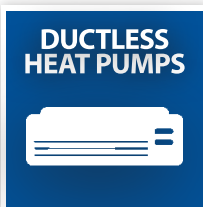
