- 1. Customer:
 - a. lives in Maine
 - b. participates in a qualifying program (LIHEAP, TANF, SNAP, or MaineCare)
 - c. pays their own electric bill
- 2. Heat pump water heater:
 - a. is an ENERGY STAR-certified heat pump water heater
 - b. was installed by a State of Maine-licensed plumber
 - c. was installed between July 1, 2018 and June 30, 2019
- 3. Claim form submitted within 30 days of installation and with copies of:
 - a. heat pump water heater receipt
 - b. plumber's invoice
 - c. documentation of customer's participation in a qualifying program (per 1.b., above, to be provided by customer to plumber in sealed envelope which is included with this form. *Customer income and program participation information is private and confidential and may not be viewed, copied, or retained.* Plumber must submit sealed envelope to Efficiency Maine promptly with this Rebate Claim Form.)
 - d. U.S. Internal Revenue Service W-9 form for plumber's company (if not on file with Efficiency Maine)
