| 13 | Homeowner taught how to turn the heat pump on and off, clean the filter, switch between heating and cooling modes, change the temperature setpoint, adjust airflow direction, and call for service |
| 14 | Homeowner understands electric bill will increase, but overall energy costs could decrease if heat pump is used optimally |
| 15 | Heat pump outdoor unit is on Efficiency Maine's list of rebate-eligible heat pumps (Heat pump / fossil fuel combination systems ("dual fuel") are not rebate eligible) |
