Basement – The combination of all floors that separate conditioned space from unconditioned space or outside air (e.g., a basement ceiling) and/or any concrete foundation wall, including the floor of a mobile home on a foundation. b. Mobile Home Underbelly – The space beneath the floor of a mobile home that is not on a foundation.
